

CLASS RULES
2021 BUXTON EXHIBITION AT TOWER HILL

ENTRIES:

This is an un-judged exhibition, for the public's education only. The exhibition is **not** a sanctioned American Begonia Society show due to the pandemic.

1. Unless specifically stated, there are no growing restrictions.
2. Plants must be exhibited as grown, e.g. if a begonia is grown in an enclosed atmosphere, it must be exhibited in an enclosed atmosphere.
3. The exhibition is open to any grower and no entry fee is required.
4. An exhibitor may enter more than one entry in each class provided each entry is a different variety. All entries must be checked with the Classification Committee who will also assist in determining plant identity, class and grooming.
5. Plants and containers must be neat, clean, proportionate to size of the plant, and pest free. No white, black, or metal nursery cans/pots are permitted. Stakes should be inconspicuous in size, color and height.
6. The Committee will safeguard the exhibits as far as possible, but cannot assume responsibility for loss or injury. Exhibitors should water their plants before entry.
7. No artificial plant material will be allowed in any class or division.
8. All entries must be of adequate size and development to make a suitable representation of that variety. Length of ownership would be welcomed on entry form.
9. Entries must be entered on **Fri. Sept. 17, 2021, between 10am and 3pm**, and **Sat. Sept. 18 from 8:30am-9:30am, only with permission from chairs**. The exhibition opens to the public on Sat. 18 at 10:00am and closes Sat. 18 at 4:00pm Entry forms are available through a Buxton Member or on site.
10. Entries may not be removed before the exhibition closes on **Sat. Sept. 18 at 4:00pm** and must all be removed by **5:00pm**.
11. Entries in Class 11, Propagation, require the age of the entry.

AWARDS:

There will be one award given, The People's Choice Award, with 1st, 2nd and 3rd places given. This will be chosen by the public and placed Saturday at 3:00pm.
